RECIPE CORNER

PEACH CLAFOUTI

2/3 cup all-purpose flour
½ cup plus 2 Tbsp. sugar, divided
1 tsp kosher salt
4 large eggs
2 ½ tsp. vanilla extract
¼ tsp almond extract
2 cups heavy whipping cream
3 cups (1/2" thick) sliced peeled peaches

In a large bowl, whisk together flour, ½ cup sugar, and salt; whisk in eggs and extracts until smooth. Gently whisk in cram until well combined. Let batter stand for 10 minutes.

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Lightly spray a 10 inch enamel coated cast iron skillet with baking spray with flour. Pour ½ of the batter (about 1 ¾ cups) into prepared pan; reserve remaining batter.

Bake until almost set 10 to 15 minutes.

In a medium bowl, stir together peaches and remaining 2 Tbsp. sugar. Gently place peaches on top of partially baked custard in concentric circles. Gently stir remaining batter; carefully pour onto peaches.

Bake until a wooden pick in the center comes out clean, about 40 minutes. Let cool on wire rack for at least 20 minutes before serving.

(Gently stir, but do not whisk remaining batter before pouring onto peaches; whisking the batter will incorporate air and create bubbles on top of the baked custard.)
