# GRILLED PORK LOIN WITH FRESH PEACH SALSA

1 (2 TO 3 LB) Boneless Pork Loin 3 Tbsp. olive oil 2 tsp. salt 1 tsp. black pepper Juice of 1 lemon 2 Tbsp. honey

#### SALSA

1 red bell pepper, seeded & diced
1 red onion, diced
1 to 2 jalapenos, diced and seeded
3 cups fresh peaches (about 3 to 4 peaches)
pitted and diced
½ cup cilantro, chopped
Zest & juice of 1 to 2 limes (about 2 to 4
Tbsp)
1 ½ tsp salt

Place pork loin, olive oil, salt and pepper, lemon juice and honey in a large zip-lock bag. Close bag; turn over several times to coat meat well. Place bag in the refrigerator for 2 to 3 hours, then allow to sit unrefrigerated for 30 minutes.

Prepare salsa. Mix all salsa ingredients in a serving bowl.

Preheat grill to medium high heat. Cook pork for 25 to 30 minutes or until center registers 145 degrees on a meat thermometer. Remove pork from heat and allow to rest for 15 minutes before slicing. Serve with peach salsa.

Makes 6 servings.
