CHAPEL OF SAINTS BENEDICT & SCHOLASTICA

If you haven't heard of the Chapel of Saints Benedict & Scholastica you are missing out. It is a beautiful chapel located on 8334 Ahles Road just 2 miles from St. Wendelin Church. It is a lovely little chapel sitting in the middle of a quiet wooded area.

In February 2016, Father Mitchell Bechtold was traveling in Ireland and felt uniquely inspired that he would someday build a church or a chapel. As he says it, "After my visit to the Cathedral in Galway, I awoke early that next morning with the clear conviction that I



would build a church or Chapel. It's a little bit difficult for me to explain, but I simply awoke and knew that it would happen." So, in Spring of 2020, since the COVID shutdowns limited the operating hours at their family café (Granite Edge Café), Father Mitchell and his dad, George, were convinced it was time to build the chapel. After two years, with blood, sweat, tears and generous help from Father Mitchell's family and people in the community, the chapel has taken shape.

"The chapel's identifying features include the altar stone and tabernacle which are fitted to sizeable Basswood tree stems, both from the same fallen tree. The 5' prayerful *Regina Caeli* ("Queen of Heaven") statue stands opposite an arched window. This window not only allows light into the chapel, and upon the statue, but transforms the building itself into a large Marian grotto. An image of Saints Benedict & Scholastica decorates the Southeastern wall, honoring the chapel's holy patrons. Refurbished pews, relocated from the Catholic Children's Home in Saint Cloud, stand arranged before the altar. And the interior color scheme reflects the vesture of the Blessed Virgin Mary, under whose spiritual mantel we find protection and comfort."

On Monday, August 22, 2022, Bishop Donald Kettler and Father Mitchell Bechtold, assisted by Deacon Dan Dullinger, led a gathering of the Catholic Faithful in the celebration of Holy Mass at the Chapel of Saints Benedict & Scholastica, This celebration marked the consecration of the altar. Over 150 people gathered from different parishes to help celebrate this glorious occasion.

Although this chapel is privately owned and maintained, it is open and available to the public as a house of prayer from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. every day of the week and located at 8334 Ahles Road St. Cloud, MN 56301.
