RECIPE CORNER

FRESH PEACH COBBLER

8 fresh peaches - peeled, pitted and sliced into thin wedges 1/4 cup white sugar 1/4 cup brown sugar 1/4 Tsp. ground cinnamon 1/8 tsp. ground nutmeg 1 tsp. fresh lemon juice 2 tsp. cornstarch 1 cup all-purpose flour 1/4 cup white sugar 1/4 cup brown sugar 1 tsp. baking powder 1/2 tsp. salt 6 Tbsp. unsalted butter, chilled and cut into small pieces 1/4 cup boiling water 3 Tbsp. white sugar 1 tsp. ground cinnamon

Preheat the oven to 425 degrees.

Combine peaches, 1/4 cup white sugar, 1/4 cup brown sugar, 1/4 tsp. cinnamon, nutmeg, lemon juice, and cornstarch in a large bowl; toss to coat evenly, and pour into a 2-quart baking dish. Bake in preheated oven for 10 minutes.

Meanwhile, combine flour, 1/4 cup white sugar, 1/4 cup brown sugar, baking powder, and salt in a large bowl. Blend in butter with your fingertips or a pastry blender until mixture resembles coarse meal. Stir in water until just combined.

Remove peaches from oven, and drop spoonfuls of topping over them.

Mix 3 tablespoons white sugar and 1 tsp. cinnamon together in a small bowl; sprinkle over entire cobbler.

Bake in the preheated oven until topping is golden, about 30 minutes.
