RECIPE CORNER

BAKED ZUCCHINI 'FRIES'

2 medium zucchini
1 large egg
½ cup panko
½ cup (1 ½ oz) grated parmesan cheese
1 tsp. garlic powder
½ tsp. freshly ground black pepper
½ cup prepared marinara sauce, for serving

Position rack in the upper third of the oven and preheat to 450 degrees. Spray a large, rimmed baking sheet with cooking spray.

Trim the ends off the zucchini, then slice each in half lengthwise. Use a small spoon to scoop out the seeds, then cut the zucchini into 3 to 4 inch long and ½ inch wide strips, shaped like French fries.

In a medium bowl whisk the egg. On a plate or shallow dish, combine the panko, parmesan cheese, garlic powder and balck pepper.

Add the zucchini to the bowl with the egg and toss to coat. Working with one piece of zucchini at a time, dip each piece into the panko mixture, pressing a bit so it adheres, then transfer to the prepared baking sheet. Repeat with the remaining zucchini and panko, then spray generously with the cooking spray.

Roast for about 15 minutes, or until the zucchini fries are tender but still firm, and nicely browned.

While the zucchini is roasting, in a small saucepan over low heat, warm the marinara sauce.

Serve the zucchini hot, with the sauce along side.


